Prayer Disciplines: Scriptural Prayer (I)

Praying with the Psalms

The Psalms are one of the most ancient forms of prayer. The Bible also records that Jesus Christ used the Psalms to pray.

Jesus: On the cross, he prayed Psalm 22:1 "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" and Psalm 31:5 "Into your hands I commit my spirit."

Early Church: The early church fathers prayed the Psalms many times each day. In fact, in the first century, this was the only form of prayer. Up till the fifth century, the Psalms formed an important part of the morning prayers of the church. In accordance with tradition, Scripture reading in liturgical churches would include reading the Psalms. Christians would use the Psalms in both corporate worship and individual devotion.

What is special about praying with the Psalms?

- 1. There is great diversity to the prayers of the Psalms. They express thanksgiving, praise, repentance, lament, trust, etc., arising from different life situations. In this way, the Psalms serve as a prayer handbook.
- 2. The prayers of the Psalms express true emotions. The one praying does not hide his/her feelings from God, but speaks honestly, and confronts one's true self, especially in times of trial. The deepest matters of one's soul are poured out to God.

- 3. The prayers of the Psalms are centred on God. We do not pray for what we desire, but what God desires. The psalmist seeks to draw near to God and yearns for a deeper relationship with the Lord. We see this in David's prayers of petition and confession, as well as the expressions of trust in God from other psalmists in various situations.
- 4. The prayers of the Psalms arise from the richness of God's Word. In other words, these prayers do not grow out of our own impoverished selves, but are based upon the promises of the Bible.

We can rediscover the spiritual experience of praying with the Psalms when we practice this discipline individually or collectively.

How can we pray with the Psalms?

Individual exercises: At least 10 minutes every day

- Read the Bible aloud: Read out the Scripture passage slowly and repeatedly, with care and attention, so that you understand what is being read. Reading the passage is itself a form of prayer.
- 2. Meditate Silently: Concentrate on certain passages or themes which resonate with you or touch your heart, and repeat them over in your mind, reflecting on how the passage is important to you and impacts your life.

- 3. Speak with God: Communicate with God in an honest and heartfelt manner and pray responsively to Him. Also wait upon God, listen to Him, experience His presence, and commune with Him.
- **4. Respond and Commit:** Pray about what you have experienced and received from God. Make a commitment to God as a response to that which He has spoken to you.

The Spiritual Discipline of Praying with the Psalms – Continuing to use the Psalms in prayer

The Psalms offer the best models of prayer for the Christian. Listed below are Psalms that we can pray under different circumstances and when faced with various needs.

1. Thanksqiving: Psalms 65,84,92,98,103,116,145

Example: Psalm 116:12-14

What shall I return to the LORD for all his goodness to me?
I will lift up the cup of salvation and call on the name of the LORD.
I will fulfill my vows to the LORD in the presence of all his people.

2. Repentance: Psalms 6,32,38,51,102,130,143

Example: Psalm 6:1-3

Lord, do not rebuke me in your anger or discipline me in your wrath.

Have mercy on me, Lord, for I am faint; heal me, Lord, for my bones are in agony. My soul is in deep anguish. How long, Lord, how long?

3. Illness: Psalms 22,32,38,39,41,77,91

Example: Psalm 39:12-13

Hear my prayer, Lord,
listen to my cry for help;
do not be deaf to my weeping.
I dwell with you as a foreigner,
a stranger, as all my ancestors were.
Look away from me, that I may enjoy life again before I depart and am no more.

4. Fear: Psalms 3,27,46,56,112,118

Example: Psalm 56:1-4

Be merciful to me, my God,
for my enemies are in hot pursuit;
all day long they press their attack.
My adversaries pursue me all day long;
in their pride many are attacking me.
When I am afraid, I put my trust in you.
In God, whose word I praise—
in God I trust and am not afraid.
What can mere mortals do to me?

5. Sorrow: Psalms 13,40,42,69

Example: Psalm 40:1-3

I waited patiently for the Lord;
he turned to me and heard my cry.
He lifted me out of the slimy pit,
out of the mud and mire;
he set my feet on a rock
and gave me a firm place to stand.
He put a new song in my mouth,
a hymn of praise to our God.
Many will see and fear the Lord
and put their trust in him.

6. Trust: Psalms 16,23,27,62,91,121,125,131

Example: Psalm 27:11-14

Teach me your way, Lord;
lead me in a straight path
because of my oppressors.

Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes,
for false witnesses rise up against me,
spouting malicious accusations.

I remain confident of this:
I will see the goodness of the Lord
in the land of the living.

Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord.

7. Separation: Psalms 27,126

Example: Psalm 27:9-10

Do not hide your face from me, do not turn your servant away in anger; you have been my helper. Do not reject me or forsake me, God my Savior. Though my father and mother forsake me,

the Lord will receive me.

Conclusion

As we make direct use of the Psalms in our prayers over days, months, and years, and practice this spiritual discipline consistently and faithfully, we will grow in spiritual maturity. Our spiritual temperaments will change, our language of prayer will be enriched, and our lives will be renewed.

Praying with Paul

Characteristics & Concerns of Paul's Prayers

- 1) Paul a **Man of Prayer** Col.4:2-4; Rm.1:9-10; 2 Tim.1:3.
- 2) Paul's prayer shows dependence on God yet not losing sight of human responsibility when he prays for spiritual transformation in believers.
 - a. By the power of the Spirit (Rm. 15:13)
 - b. According to God's grace (Eph. 1:7-8)
 - c. According to will of God (Rm.15:31-32; 1 Cor.1:8-9)
- 3) Paul's concern in prayer is to glorify God
 - a. God glorified (Rm.15:6b; Php.1:9-11; Eph.3:20-21)
- 4) Paul's concern in prayer is for believers to be established in their Christian life.
 - Spirit of wisdom & revelation to enlighten the believers to know God (Eph.1:17-18).
 - b. Power of God to know the love of God and to be filled by the love of God (Eph.3:17-19)
 - Fruit bearing life, growth in knowledge of God and strengthened with power to live life pleasing to God (Col.1:9-12)
 - d. Grow in holiness and sanctification (1 The.4:3; 1 The.5:23-24)

Examples of Using Paul's Prayers for Our Prayers

1) Praying for Ourselves

Colossians 3:3-17

Scripture Passage: ³ For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

⁵ Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. ⁶ Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. ⁷ You used to walk in these ways, in the life you once lived. ⁸ But now you must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. ⁹ Do not lie to each other, since you have taken off your old self with its practices ¹⁰ and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator. ¹¹ Here there is no Gentile or Jew, circumcised or uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave or free, but Christ is all, and is in all.

¹² Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ¹³ Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. ¹⁴ And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

¹⁵ Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. ¹⁶ Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. ¹⁷ And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all

in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Prayer: Colossians 3:3-17

Dear Heavenly Father, we have died, and our life is now hidden with Christ in God. We know that when Christ appears again we will appear with him in glory.

Help us therefore to put to death whatever belongs to our earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming. We used to walk in these ways but now we rid ourselves of all such things: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language, dishonesty and lying. Help us Lord, to take off our old self with its practices and to put on the new self, that is being renewed in the image of our Creator, where there is no distinction between social class, and religious race denominations, but we are all equal in Christ.

As God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, we therefore ask that You clothe us with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Help us, O Lord, to bear with each other and forgive one another as You had forgiven us, and over all these virtues help us to put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

We ask that the peace of Christ rule in our hearts because we as members of one body were called to peace. And for this we are thankful. Let the message of Christ dwell in us richly, that we may teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in our hearts. And help us do all things, whether in word or deed, in the name of our Lord Jesus, always giving thanks to God the Father through him.

2) Praying for Others

• Ephesians 1:15-20

Scripture Passage: ¹⁵ For this reason, ever since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all God's people, ¹⁶ I have not stopped giving thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers. ¹⁷ I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit^[f] of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. ¹⁸ I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, ¹⁹ and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength ²⁰ he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, ²¹ far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.

Prayer: Ephesians 1:17-19a

I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you (name) spiritual wisdom and revelation in growing knowledge of him--since the eyes of your (his/her) heart have been enlightened--so that you (he/ she) may know what is the hope of God's calling, what is the wealth of God's glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the incomparable greatness of God's power toward all who believe

• Ephesians 3:14-21

Scripture Passage: ¹⁴ For this reason I kneel before the Father, ¹⁵ from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. ¹⁶ I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸ may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

²⁰ Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us, ²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

Prayer: Ephesians 3:16-19

I pray that according to the wealth of his glory [the Father] may strengthen you (name) with power through his Spirit in the inner person, that Christ may dwell in your (his/her) heart through faith, so that, because you have (he/she has) been rooted and grounded in love, you (he/she), together with all the Lord's holy people, may be able to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge, so that you (he/she) may be filled up to all the fullness of God.

Colossians 1:9-14

Scripture Passage: ⁹ For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom and understanding that the Spirit gives, ¹⁰ so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, ¹¹ being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, ¹² and giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light. ¹³ For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, ¹⁴ in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.
